CODE OF CONDUCT

This code applies to all persons representing Coast and Valley Swimming Association and Swimming New South Wales in any capacity.

1. All activities of the tour/competition/camp for the team must be attended. If you cannot attend a squad activity, you must notify the Development Coordinator by email-E: cvsadevelopment@gmail.com
2. There will be no consumption of alcohol, drugs or the smoking of cigarettes while on tour.
3. Once registered with the Manager, there are no departures without the approval of the Manager and the Head Coach.
4. Best behaviour will be required at all times. As a squad member you are representing Swimming NSW, Coast and Valley, your club, your family and the Sponsors. **No discredit should be brought to any of the above.**
5. No disrespect will be tolerated under any circumstances.
6. Any problems are to be immediately reported to the Manager and/or Head Coach.
7. If swimmers are not fully satisfied following any of the meals on the tour, they should immediately go to the Team Manager(s). You are not permitted to take action into your own hands.
8. All selected members of any CVSA Development Activity are required to wear any provided uniform which could include CVSA cap and/or shirt. No exceptions will be made.
9. While on the Team you may be sharing rooms with fellow team members of the same sex. There will be:
 - No interference with other people's property
 - Rooms and property are to be treated with respect
 - Any use of telephones and other services are at your expense
 - No person is to be in the room of another swimmer after the "Lights Out" or during compulsory rest time
 - Mobile phones will not be used after 8pm
10. Breaches of any Code of Conduct Rules may lead to immediate expulsion from the tour. Parents/Carers will be contacted and appropriate travel arrangements will be made. Any additional expenses incurred will be either the swimmer's responsibility or that of the swimmer's Parents. A full written report will be submitted to SWIMMING NSW and Coast and Valley Swimming Association.
11. All instructions from the Managers and Coaches are to be adhered to. Any problems or difficulties are to be raised with the Head Manager.
