### Round 1 - Open water series

14 South Shore swimmers competed in the first round of the Open Water Series at Cottesloe last Sunday: Mathew Beck, Ben Brbich, Max Coten, Bella Dans, Cullen Dans, Will Gurr, Jayde Halvorson, Caitlyn James, Maddie Joy, Katie McFarlane, Kelly Rasmusen, Fin Schaper, Sabrina Seitz and Jeremy Shaw. Kelly Rasmusen came 4th overall and 2nd in the Girls 18/O 1.25 km (although she's not yet 18, not sure what happened there) in a time of 19.12. Bella Dans and Max Coten both put in fantastic swims in their first efforts over this distance. Ben Brbich was very unlucky to come 3rd overall and 2nd in the Boys 17/U in the 2.5km after leading almost the entire race (there was almost nothing separating the first 3 placegetters). Jeremy Shaw was 4th and Will Gurr 5th in 17/U and Mathew Beck 3rd in the 14/U with all our swimmers getting fantastic times. Maddie Joy came 4th and Katie 7th in their respective age groupings for the same event. All swimmers over this distance produced PBs. Caitlyn James, Fin Schaper, Jayde Halvorson, Cullen Dans and Sabrina Seitz all finished creditably in the 5km event, although conditions were difficult in the last third of the race and no-one managed to PB. Well done everyone who competed! Bring on Series 2 at City Beach next Sunday – but please put in your entries well before the deadline as Round 1 entries closed early.
