



Melbourne Vicentre Relay Policy

This Melbourne Vicentre (MVC) Relay Policy details the MVC relay selection process and requires all swimmers compete in relays according to the Rules of Swimming.

All MVC staff, including volunteers, and members are bound by this policy

- Representing MVC in relay teams, where they are included in the program at a competition, is a condition of Club membership
- When a member enters a competition where relays are included in the program, they do so with the understanding that they may be selected onto an MVC relay team. That swimmer will be available and prepared to represent the Club
- Relay teams will be finalised by the Head Coach each morning of the competition for that day's relay events. Selected swimmers will be notified accordingly. At Australian Championship competitions consideration will be given to individual swimmer programs
- Swimmers selected in relay events are expected to prepare and race to the best of their ability. Failure to do so can lead to withdrawal from future individual events
- After receiving race instruction from coaching staff, all four swimmers are to report to the Team Manager before marshalling together
- Members representing MVC in a relay team will abide by rules governing the sport of swimming
